ZENN ELECTRIC CAR IN COLUMBUS

In these days of high gas prices, the City of Columbus has an electric car on display at City Hall on Thursday, July 3.

The Zenn electric car, courtesy of Green Autos, Janesville, will also be driven in the Columbus Fourth of July parade which begins at 12:00 Noon.

The zero emission, zero noise Zenn is battery powered and can provide up to 35 miles of travel on a single charge and has a regulated maximum speed of 25 mpg.
